Class Fees and Registration:

- Office/Paramedic Fee: \$10/weekend/entry.
- In-Hand and Performance (Classes 1-18): \$12 each with pre-registration, \$15 each day of show.
- Dressage & Combined Tests (Classes 19-39): \$15 for ACPS members, non-members \$20 per test.
- Jumping Classes will be handled by Horse Shows In the Park (HSIP). They will have a separate office to handle your registration. See complete schedule and entry forms at <http://horseshowsinthepark.com/hj.html> Look for the Hunter Jumper show dated June 25-26.
- Please fill out a separate entry form for each rider/handler and pony combination. Changes may be made day of show with Secretary. If same pony is entered with different rider/handler, please include stabling on one entry only.
- Pre-registration must be received by the Show Organizer no later than June 15, 2011. Entries may be mailed or scanned/mailed to pcwertb@yahoo.com.
- Do not send payment with your entry. Please bring a blank check to the Secretary at check-in. Fees will be totaled during or immediately following the show at your convenience. Make Checks Payable to ACPS Region IV.
- Current negative Coggins dated within one year must accompany entry or be presented to Secretary at check-in.

Stabling is available Friday through Sunday. Check-in time Friday 12:00pm. Stall assignments will be posted at the barn but all Connemarans will be in Barn A. ACPS member stalls are \$40 for Fri/Sat nights (not available per day). Non-members will pay \$72 for the weekend (the rate for HSIP competitors). *Dressage Only – As Dressage is only offered on Saturday, Dressage only competitors who are non-ACPS members will pay \$45 for stall for Friday night/Saturday.* Sunday night stabling is available for an additional \$10. Initial bedding provided, additional bedding available at Canterbury, stalls typically well bedded. Ship-in fees apply for non-stabled horses @\$10/day. RV hookups are available @\$28/night. Paddocks are \$30/night.

The ACPS Show Secretary will be available for check-in Friday afternoon at 12:00 pm EDT. Schooling is allowed from 1 to 6pm but competitors MUST wear either a dressage bridle number or the hunter/jumper number while schooling. If you want to jump school, you must check in with the HSIP office to receive your back number.

Facility Rules:

- All dogs must be leashed and controlled while on the show grounds.
- ASTM-SEI approved helmets and appropriate footwear is required at all times when mounted on show grounds.

Concessions are available on Show Grounds. Photographer will be on grounds.

Only Open tests are available for professionals to enter. Derby Classes will be an outside course of 8 - 12 fences that are natural obstacles and will be judged on optimum time (325 meters per minute). Derby Classes will not be run prior to 3pm on Saturday.

(Connemara Leadline will be on Sunday)

Entries for jumping will be managed by HSIP and you MUST register with the show secretary for HSIP and pay them the fees to jump. Connemara points will accrue in the above classes only, although you are welcome to enter other classes for warm up purposes.

Rules of Competition

- 1) In all Classes
 - a. Adults may show ponies.
 - b. Stallions may be shown by juniors.
 - c. Classes may be omitted or split by age, gender, size or breed at the discretion of Show Management.
 - d. Six places will be pinned in all classes, unless otherwise specified.
- 2) **In-Hand.** All competitors will be asked to walk, trot and stand for inspection at the judge's direction.
- 3) It is not necessary to register for **Championship** classes. Only a Champion and Reserve Champion will be pinned.
- 4) **Mountain & Moorland** is open to purebred or halfbred ponies of UK Native breeds **not** represented in the previous breed classes: Shetland, Exmoor, Welsh, Highland, Dales, Fell, New Forest.
- 5) **Baby Obedience.** Open to all breeds 2yo and under. Competitors will be challenged by a series of tasks in the ring at the judge's direction.
- 6) **Dressage**
 - a. All Intro and USEA tests will be ridden in a Small arena, standard arena for Training Level and up.
 - b. Dressage classes must be pre-registered so that ride times may be assigned. Ride times will be posted to the website by June 22.
 - c. Ride times may be rescheduled to allow each competitor to participate in Performance classes. If there are time conflicts, the Dressage rider should re-schedule their ride with the Show Secretary
- 7) **Dressage Test of Choice.** Competitor must specify their USEF 2011 Test of Choice on the pre-registration form.
- 8) Cumulative points in dressage, hunters and jumpers will be tabulated for **High Point Connemara** award. Open to Purebred & Halfbred Connemaras.
- 9) Cumulative points in dressage, hunters and jumpers will be tabulated for **High Point Rider** award.
- 10) Highest Dressage Score will be awarded to **Best Dressage Score Connemara.** Open to Purebred & Halfbred Connemaras.
- 11) A Champion will be pinned for **Hunters and Jumpers.**
