- 3. Halfbred Championship: Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of class 1 & 2
- 4. Purebred Connemara Gelding: Connemara Geldings 3 years old and over
- 5. Purebred Mares: Connemara mares ages 3 years old and over
- **6.** Purebred Connemara Stallion: Connemara Stallion age 3 and older
- 7. Purebred Championship: Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of class 4, 5 and 6
- **8. Purebred Youngstock:** Purebred fillies and colts and geldings 2 years of age and under
- 9. Halfbred Youngstock: Halfbred fillies colts or gelding 2 years and under
- 10. Youngstock Championship: Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of class 8 and 9

- **21.Leadline:** Open to our future Connemara riders
- 22.Walk/Trot Pleasure: Judged on performance, manners and suitability
- **23.Open Pleasure Senior:** Walk /trot/canter both directions May be asked to back. Judged on performance, manners and suitability.
- **24.Open Pleasure Junior:** Walk /trot/canter both directions May be asked w
- **25.Hunter Under Saddle Jr:** w/t/c both directions. Judged on manners and way of going.
- **26.Hunter Under Saddle Sr:** w/t/c both directions. Judged on manners and way of going.
- **27.Trail Class Ridden Senior:** Negotiate 10 trail type obstacles. Points given for each obstacle. Rider with the most points wins. All obstacles are optional. In the event of a tie, the fastest time will determine the winner.
- **28.Trail Class Ridden Junior:** Negotiate 10 trail type obstacles. Points given for each obstacle. Rider with the most points wins. All obstacles are optional. In the event of a tie, the fastest time will determine the winner.

- 1. Our show runs on volunteers and without them we have no show. If anyone is able to help out at our show, please contact the show manager. Your help is much needed and much appreciated.
- 2. We will do our best to see that thing run smoothly. Your feedback is appreciated.
- 3. The show committee would like to remind all competitors, family and spectators to practice good sportsmanship throughout the weekend. We are all here to have fun!
- 4. All ponies in Connemara classes must be registered and exhibited under their registered names.
- 5. ASTM certified helmets are required at all times when mounted.
- 6. Adult may show ponies in any class unless class is specified as Junior. Juniors are those who are 18 years of age or under.
- 7. Stabling is \$25/night and includes 1 bag of shavings. Additional shavings can be purchased from the park at \$9/bag; There is a \$25 refundable stall deposit required. Stall must be cleaned and stripped when you leave or deposit will be forfeited.
- 8. Please do not use any staples or screws on the stalls.
- 9. All manure must e disposed of in designated areas and only bedding and manure!
- 10. Camper/RV hookups are \$25/night.
- 11. All dogs must be kept on a leash.
- 12. **All horses must have proof of a negative coggins**. If you are shipping in from out of state, remember that a health certificate will need to be presented at the AG station once you enter the state.
- 13. Entry fees for all classes are \$15/class. Please make check payable to ACPS Region IV.
- 14. Closing date is 11/14. All entries postmarked before closing date will be listed in the Show program.
- 15. Fees for the POP 3 phase show are separate and payable to The Partners of the Park.

- 17. Concessions will be available on the show grounds.

Florida Horse Park Release Form

FLORIDA AGRICULTURE & HORSE PARK AUTHORITY, INC. COMPLETE RELEASE FROM LIABILITY IN CASE OF INJURY OR LOSS, WAIVER INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

I/we understand that horseback riding and related activities, such as eventing and jumping, are very dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death, and/or property damage, including injury and/or death to horses, spectators and others.

Accordingly, I/we agree that any activity engaged in by me on the premises owned by the state of Florida, or related to horses or horseback riding, if on the premises, is done at my own risk.

Accordingly, I/we release and agree to hold harmless the state of Florida, the Florida Agriculture & Horse Park Authority along with it's board of directors and employees, and any and all persons or entities who are guarantors or indemnitors of the above, all agents, employees, promotors, sponsors, other horse riders, horse owners, advertisers, sales persons, photographers, volunteers, (hereinafter called Releasees) from all liability for negligence or otherwise.

I/we assume full responsibility for the risk of bodily injury, illness, death of myself and/or my horse(s) and any property damage due to the negligence of Releasees or otherwise while the premises owned by the state of Florida, the Florida Agriculture & Horse Park Authority along with it's board of directors and employees or heavily engaged in horseback riding-related activities, and/or while training, riding, competing, officiating, observing, volunteering, teaching, boarding, working for, or for any purpose relating to horseback riding, eventing or participating as rider or spectator in such activities.

I/we agree not to sue any Releasees, and I/we release and agree to indemnity for the Releasees from and for all liability for the undersigned, his/her person, representatives, assignees, heirs, and demands therefore on account of injury to her person or property, or death of undersigned whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise.

I/we agree that this release, waiver and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of this state where these activities are conducted, and if any part hereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall continue of full force and effect.

I/we have read and voluntarily signed the release and waiver of liability and indemnity agreement and further agree that no oral representations, statements or inducements apart from the foregoing written agreements have been made nor shall be made except by a written and signed addendum.
